

# Used Oil Filters

- 2009 Wisconsin Act bans the landfilling of used oil filters as of January 1, 2011.
- The ban specifically covers filters from motor vehicles, these include oil filters from: cars, trucks, buses, motorcycles, snowmobiles, forklifts, tractors, ATVs and UTVs
- The ban applies to everyone in the state, including individuals, farmers, businesses, commercial or industrial facilities, and other organizations. The law does not exempt any groups or classes of individuals.
- Town of Lomira residents must drain oil filters at least 24 hours before bringing them in for recycling. Drain filters by poking a hole in the bottom of filter. This aids to fully drain the filter.
- As of March 23, 2012, oil absorbent materials, such as rags, wipes, and litter, etc. may be disposed in the landfill provided there is no free-flowing oil in the absorbent material and the absorbents are not hazardous waste.
